Treasurer Bill Beaudin reports as follows:

balance also includes a total of \$7,000.00 from residential contractors as deposits for

potential road damages that may occur during new home construction. The checking

account also includes \$2,125.00 which is now shown as Pool Fob Deposits Equity

Reserve.

2. Money Market balance at the end of April was \$ 105,273.63 which includes interest

earned for March of \$4.33.

I am also looking for volunteers to help open and close the pool this summer. Each volunteer takes a week beginning on Sunday and ending on Saturday. The pool opens at 9:00 am each morning (weather permitting) and closes at 8:00pm calendars for sign-up will be at the pool opening on the 17th.

Pool Ty Boswell reports as follows:

The pool has passed inspection by the Lee County Health Department and will open on May 17th at Pool Social.

As a reminder, pets and glass containers are not allowed in the pool area. This is a state health code policy and part of our Operation Permit requirement from the county. Recently, there has been unauthorized access by persons jumping the fence. This can also put our Operation Permit in jeopardy for the year, especially if people go into the pool area after dark. If observed, please report unauthorized access or access afterhours to a member of the POA board.

CTA Chair Tom Hanley reports as follows:

E-Sticker Clean Up is Coming: There are more than 12,000 e-stickers in our system. Volunteers will be working to clean up and deactivate e-stickers that, by January 1, 2026, have not been used within the last three years. Any e-sticker deactivated in error can be reactivated. The clean-up of this database will help keep backup costs down and keep the system working as quickly as possible. Tri River water company- New 3-year budge coming out State Carolina Trace #2 largest community receiving water service.

CTA audit being done now.

Voted to have Northside back gate completely closed till exit gate gets repaired- voted down- maintenance on gate vendor taking too long.

Roads and Grounds Tom Hanley reports as follows:
